The **Future Faculty Program (FFP)** is offered by the **Center for Advancing Teaching and Learning Through Research (CATLR)** to prepare graduate students and postdoctoral fellows for teaching responsibilities in higher education.

## Who is the Future Faculty Program for?



**Graduate students and postdoctoral fellows** from all disciplines at Northeastern who would like to develop and reflect on their teaching practice as well as prepare for future opportunities for teaching in higher education. You do not need any prior teaching experience, or to currently be a TA or instructor. You only need to be interested in expanding your knowledge and skills in teaching and learning.

## What do Future Faculty Program participants do?



**DO** - Engage in CATLR programming and related opportunities to develop in key areas of teaching and learning.



**REFLECT** - Connect what you learn to your own past, current, or future teaching practice.



**CREATE** - Draft materials that will help you prepare for the academic job market.

## What are the benefits of completing the Future Faculty Program?



Since the Future Faculty Program is **self-paced**, participants can dedicate anywhere from a semester to multiple years during their time at Northeastern to complete program requirements, depending on their availability and interests.



Participants who satisfy the program requirements receive a **letter of completion**.



Prepare for faculty-level teaching responsibilities and receive feedback on materials for the **academic job market**.
